

RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE REST AREA FESTIVAL AREA217

Article 1 – Purpose

These rules govern the functioning of the rest area of the Festival AREA217 which runs from 30 June 2017 to 02 July 2017.

These rules of procedure are posted at the entrance to the rest area and at the reception desk. It is given to each festival-goer who requests it.

Article 2 - Conditions of admission and residence

2.1 The rest area is part of the former BA217 air base.

The access is free and is strictly reserved for the holders of a package 2 or 3 days for the festival AREA217. The package will be required 2 or 3 days, the camping ticket as well as an ID. In exchange, a "camping bracelet" will be given to the festival-goer.

Staying on the sleeping area implies acceptance of the provisions of this by-law and commitment to comply.

2.2 Opening and closing times

The rest area will be accessible from Friday June 30th at 4pm until Monday, July 3rd at 11am maximum.

2.3 Authorized Material

The rest area is only for tents. The sardines used to plant tents should not exceed 30 cm.

No object more than 30 cm can be planted in the ground.

2.4 Installation

Outdoor accommodation and related equipment must be installed at the location indicated in accordance with the instructions given by the stage manager or his representative.

2.5 Reception desk

A reception is provided day and night. It informs you about available pitches, safety rules, accessible services (transport, breakfasts) and distributes garbage bags. You can also find the artists' schedules or the location of the rescue stations.

2.6 visitors

No person who is not the holder of the "camping bracelet" will be allowed to enter the rest area.

2.7 Animals

Access to the rest area is strictly forbidden to festivalgoers coming with animals, except dogs accompanying the visually impaired.

Article 3 - Police formalities

Access to the rest area is strictly forbidden to even accompanied minors.

Article 4 - Security

4.1 PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Glass bottle
- Fireworks or Bengal lights
- Burners and other gas installations
- Sharp objects
- Any weapon within the meaning of legal term
- Narcotics
- Animals
- Musical Instrument
- Gasoline or any flammable substance
- Paint can
- Cars, motorcycles, trailers, caravans, camper vans

4.2 A first aid kit is located at the reception desk.

4.3 Vol

Although the sleeping area is monitored day and night, we advise you to leave your valuables at home and take care of your personal belongings. A paying deposit will be made available to the festival-goers.

4.4 Security checks

Anyone wishing to enter the rest area or already present in the rest area should let the reception or security staff check the contents of the bags and suitcases.

All festival goers will have to undergo a systematic search of the bags and a palpation of the people.

Anyone not wishing to comply with this device will be denied access to the rest area.

5 - Infringement of Regulation

In the event that a festival-goer disrupts the stay of other users or fails to comply with the by-law, the representative of the festival in charge of the rest area may, if he deems it necessary, His expulsion from the rest area.

In the event of a criminal offense, the festival may appeal to the police.
